

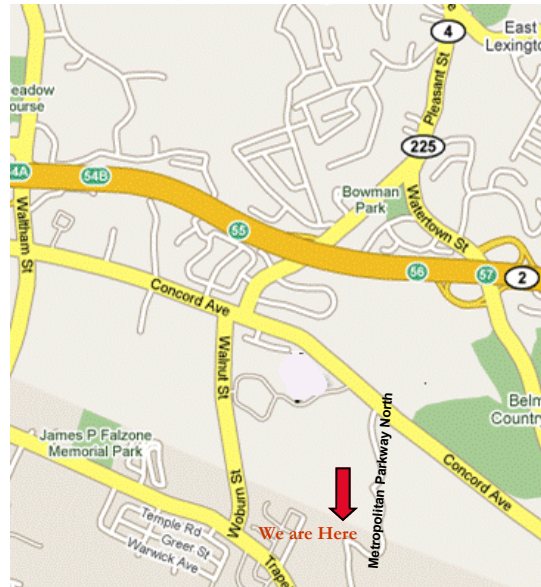

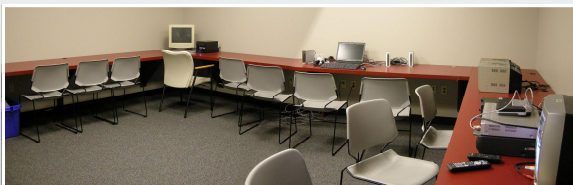

- Conference room seats 14 and wired for a ceiling mounted video projector.

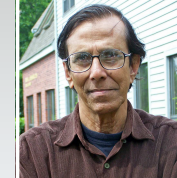

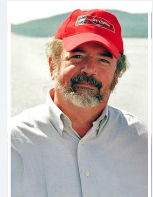
